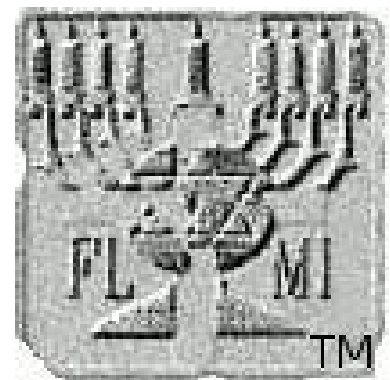

Rom. 3:23 KJV

(23) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Rom. 6:23 KJV

(23) For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Rom. 5:8 KJV

(8) But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Rom. 10:9-10,13 KJV

(9) That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

(10) For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

(13) For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

John 3:3 KJV

(3) Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

John 3:16 KJV

(16) For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Eph. 2:8-9 KJV

(8) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: [it is] the gift of God:

(9) Not of works, lest any man should boast.

1 John 1:9 KJV

(9) If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

2 Cor. 5:17 KJV

(17) Therefore if any man [be] in Christ, [he is] a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

(17) So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Jude 1:20 KJV

(20) But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

1 Pet. 1:7-9 KJV

(7) That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:

(8) Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see [him] not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory:

(9) Receiving the end of your faith, [even] the salvation of [your] souls.

James 1:5-8 KJV

(5) If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all [men] liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

(6) But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

(7) For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.

(8) A double minded man [is] unstable in all his ways.

Rom. 4:20-21 KJV

(20) He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

(21) And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

2 Cor. 5:7 KJV

(7) (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

Mark 11:24 KJV

(24) Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive [them], and ye shall have [them].

James 2:18,22 KJV

(18) Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.

(22) Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect?

Heb. 10:32-39 KJV

(32) But call to remembrance the former days, in which, after ye were illuminated, ye endured a great fight of afflictions;

(33) Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used.

(34) For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.

(35) Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.

(36) For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

(37) For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry.

(38) Now the just shall live by faith: but if [any man] draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

(39) But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.

To control your tongue

Prov. 18:21 KJV

(21) Death and life [are] in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Eph. 4:29, 31-32 KJV

(29) Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

(31) Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

(32) And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

Prov. 13:3 KJV

(3) He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: [but] he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

Luke 6:45 KJV

(45) A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.

Matt. 12:36 KJV

(36) But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

James 1:26 KJV

(26) If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion [is] vain.

1 Pet. 3:10 KJV

(10) For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile:

James 3:6, 10-11 KJV

(6) And the tongue [is] a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.

(10) Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be.

(11) Doth a fountain send forth at the same place sweet [water] and bitter?

Prov. 18:7-8 KJV

(7) A fool's mouth [is] his destruction, and his lips [are] the snare of his soul.

(8) The words of a talebearer [are] as wounds, and they go down into the innermost parts of the belly.

Psa. 50:23 KJV

(23) Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth [his] conversation [aright] will I shew the salvation of God.

To deal with offenses

Matt. 18:15 KJV

(15) Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother.

Matt. 5:23-24 KJV

(23) Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee;

(24) Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.

Matt. 18:21-35 KJV

(21) Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?

(22) Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

(23) Therefore is the kingdom of heaven likened unto a certain king, which would take account of his servants.

(24) And when he had begun to reckon, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents.

(25) But forasmuch as he had not to pay, his lord commanded him to be sold, and his wife, and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made.

(26) The servant therefore fell down, and worshipped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.

(27) Then the lord of that servant was moved with compassion, and loosed him, and forgave him the debt.

(28) But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellowservants, which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took [him] by the throat, saying, Pay me that thou owest.

(29) And his fellowservant fell down at his feet, and besought him, saying, Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.

(30) And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt.

(31) So when his fellowservants saw what was done, they were very sorry, and came and told unto their lord all that was done.

(32) Then his lord, after that he had called him, said unto him, O thou wicked servant, I forgave thee all that debt, because thou desiredst me:

(33) Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee?

(34) And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him.

(35) So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.

Matt. 6:14-15 KJV

(14) For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:

(15) But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

2 Cor 2:10-11 KJV

(10) To whom ye forgive any thing, I [forgive] also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave [it], for your sakes [forgave I it] in the person of Christ;

(11) Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.

Psa. 119:165 KJV

(165) Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

John 13:35 KJV

(35) By this shall all [men] know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.

1 John 4:20-21 KJV

(20) If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?

(21) And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.

To get along with others

Matt. 7:12 KJV

(12) Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

Rom. 12:10 KJV

(10) [Be] kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another;

1 John 4:20-21 KJV

(20) If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?

(21) And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.

1 Cor. 13:4-7 KJV

(4) Charity suffereth long, [and] is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

(5) Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

(6) Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;

(7) Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.

Eph. 4:31-32 KJV

(31) Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

(32) And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

Rom. 15:1-2 KJV

(1) We then that are strong ought to bear the infirmities of the weak, and not to please ourselves.

(2) Let every one of us please [his] neighbour for [his] good to edification.

Col. 3:12-14 KJV

(12) Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

(13) Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also [do] ye.

(14) And above all these things [put on] charity, which is the bond of perfectness.

Prov. 18:24 KJV

(24) A man [that hath] friends must shew himself friendly: and there is a friend [that] sticketh closer than a brother.

To overcome the devil

Eph. 6:10-17 KJV

(10) Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

(11) Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

(12) For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places].

(13) Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

(14) Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

(15) And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

(16) Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

(17) And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

James 4:7-8 KJV

(7) Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

(8) Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse [your] hands, [ye] sinners; and purify [your] hearts, [ye] double minded.

1 Pet. 5:8-10 KJV

(8) Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

(9) Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

(10) But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle [you].

Eph. 4:26-27 KJV

(26) Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:

(27) Neither give place to the devil.

2 Thes. 3:3 KJV

(3) But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep [you] from evil.

2 Cor. 2:10-11 KJV

(10) To whom ye forgive any thing, I [forgive] also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave [it], for your sakes [forgave I it] in the person of Christ;

(11) Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.

2 Tim. 4:18 KJV

(18) And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve [me] unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom [be] glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Heb. 2:18 KJV

(18) For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted.

1 John 3:8 KJV

(8) He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

Psa. 91:3-7 KJV

(3) Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.

(4) He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.

(5) Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;

(6) Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.

(7) A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.

Psa. 121:7-8 KJV

(7) The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul.

(8) The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.

To overcome lust

1 Cor. 6:15-20 KJV

(15) Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make [them] the members of an harlot? God forbid.

(16) What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh.

(17) But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.

(18) Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.

(19) What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost [which is] in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

(20) For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Gal. 5:16-17 KJV

(16) [This] I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

(17) For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

1 Cor. 10:13 KJV

(13) There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God [is] faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear [it].

Eph. 4:22-24,27 KJV

(22) That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

(23) And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

(24) And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

(27) Neither give place to the devil.

Prov. 6:25-26 KJV

(25) Lust not after her beauty in thine heart; neither let her take thee with her eyelids.

(26) For by means of a whorish woman [a man is brought] to a piece of bread: and the adulteress will hunt for the precious life.

James 1:13-15 KJV

(13) Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:

(14) But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.

(15) Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

To handle problems & trials

1 Pet. 4:12-13,16 KJV

(12) Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:

(13) But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy.

(16) Yet if [any man suffer] as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf.

Isa. 43:2-3 KJV

(2) When thou passest through the waters, I [will be] with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.

(3) For I [am] the LORD thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour: I gave Egypt [for] thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.

Psa. 31:1-5, 7-8 KJV

(1) To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in thy righteousness.

(2) Bow down thine ear to me; deliver me speedily: be thou my strong rock, for an house of defence to save me.

(3) For thou [art] my rock and my fortress; therefore for thy name's sake lead me, and guide me.

(4) Pull me out of the net that they have laid privily for me: for thou [art] my strength.

(5) Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth.

(7) I will be glad and rejoice in thy mercy: for thou hast considered my trouble; thou hast known my soul in adversities;

(8) And hast not shut me up into the hand of the enemy: thou hast set my feet in a large room.

Psa. 69:14-18 KJV

(14) Deliver me out of the mire, and let me not sink: let me be delivered from them that hate me, and out of the deep waters.

(15) Let not the waterflood overflow me, neither let the deep swallow me up, and let not the pit shut her mouth upon me.

(16) Hear me, O LORD; for thy lovingkindness [is] good: turn unto me according to the multitude of thy tender mercies.

(17) And hide not thy face from thy servant; for I am in trouble: hear me speedily.

(18) Draw nigh unto my soul, [and] redeem it: deliver me because of mine enemies.

Psa. 34:17-19 KJV

(17) [The righteous] cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.

(18) The LORD [is] nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

(19) Many [are] the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.

Psa. 55:22 KJV

(22) Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.

2 Cor. 4:7-10 KJV

(7) But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.

(8) [We are] troubled on every side, yet not distressed; [we are] perplexed, but not in despair;

(9) Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed;

(10) Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body.

1 Pet. 5:7 KJV

(7) Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

To face serious illness

James 5:14-15 KJV

(14) Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

(15) And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Psa. 103:2-3 KJV

(2) Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

(3) Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

Isa. 53:5

(5) But he [was] wounded for our transgressions, [he was] bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace [was] upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Mark 16:18 KJV

(18) They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Matt. 15:22-28 KJV

(22) And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, [thou] Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil.

(23) But he answered her not a word. And his disciples came and besought him, saying, Send her away; for she crieth after us.

(24) But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

(25) Then came she and worshipped him, saying, Lord, help me.

(26) But he answered and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast [it] to dogs.

(27) And she said, Truth, Lord: yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table.

(28) Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great [is] thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.

Matt. 9:5-6 KJV

(5) For whether is easier, to say, [Thy] sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and walk?

(6) But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.

Matt. 9:20-22 KJV

(20) And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind [him], and touched the hem of his garment:

(21) For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole.

(22) But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

Acts 3:2-8 KJV

(2) And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;

(3) Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms.

(4) And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us.

(5) And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them.

(6) Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

(7) And he took him by the right hand, and lifted [him] up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

(8) And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.

2 Kings 20:1-7 KJV
