(Father Oldest male, Prayer for family - wife - children)then.

Daddy/Eldest Male - prayer;

Jesus/Yeshua said, "I am the vine, you are the branches. If a man remains in Me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing." We bless and thank You L-rd G-d, for creating the fruit of the vine; in our lives, and in this world. (Drink some wine or grape juice)

Jesus/Yeshua said that it is not what goes into a man that makes him unclean, but what comes out of him. While we obey His commands concerning the washing of hands, may we not forget the importance of washing our hearts with His blood.

(Wash hands)

Jesus/Yeshua said, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me will never go hungry." We bless and thank You L-rd G-d, for providing us with Your bread of life and the bread on this table.
